



Technology Services

The Clinton-Macomb Public Library is pleased to offer our residents and visitors a variety of unique technical services and amenities.



Public Computers The public computer stations at all locations are equipped with high speed internet access, multiple USB and memory stick ports, a CD/DVD burner and an abundance of software. Software includes:

- Microsoft Office Suite 2010 including Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Access, OneNote, SharePoint and InfoPath Designer.
- Basic Media Editing software including Paint.NET (photo editing), Freemake Video Converter, Windows DVD maker and Windows Movie Maker.
- Content Development software including Audacity, Avidemux, Blender, eclipse, FileZilla, Inkscape, Scribus and Visual Studio Express 2013 Web for users interested in audio and video editing, software development, graphic editing or creating page layouts.



Wi-Fi CMPL's three locations offer free wireless internet access to all card-holders. You must provide your own computer with a wireless card.



Fax Service (out-going only) is available at the Main Adult Nonfiction desk (on the second floor). The cost of the fax is \$1 for each page. Files can be sent to any fax machine in the United States and Canada, and a confirmation receipt is provided. Recently, the Branch locations added a self-serve fax machine for \$1.75 first page and \$1.25 additional pages.



Wireless Printing is also available at all three locations, but does require that you have a library card to log on and release your print jobs.


Copies CMPL's three locations offer black & white copies for 10¢ per page and color copies for 50¢ per page.



Scanning Main Library's computer lab and the new South Branch computer lab has flatbed scanners at each computer station. Patrons can scan images, book pages, files, and more to create a digital copy for archiving or emailing as an attachment.



Disc Repair Give your scratched, skipping, won't play DVDs, CDs and videogames a second chance by taking them to the Circulation Desk at the Main Library for evaluation. Using a commercial-grade repair unit, we may be able to buff your discs. Repair cost is \$3 per DVD or CD and \$5 per videogame. Drop off your discs and have them repaired within a week!



Digitizing Services Within the Donald W. Green Local History room at the Main Library, CMPL offers a high-volume photo scanner and a VHS to DVD converter to residents of Clinton and Macomb Townships. The high volume scanner can be used to quickly digitize a stack of old photos. The VHS to DVD converter allows you to play

back VHS tapes (in real time) and save a copy onto a DVD (you must supply) for archiving purposes. These are self-serve stations and we provide step-by-step manuals to assist you through the process.
